### **Law textbook wins 2009 McGuffey Longevity Award**

**St. Petersburg, FL, March 4, 2009** --- The Text and Academic Authors Association (TAA) awarded the 7<sup>th</sup> edition of *Hotel, Restaurant & Travel Law: A Preventative Approach*, by Karen Morris, Norman Cournoyer, and Anthony Marshall, the 2009 McGuffey Longevity Award in the college level Humanities/Social Science category. The book is published by published by Delmar, Learning.

Text and Academic Authors created the McGuffey Longevity Awards in 1993 to recognize textbooks and learning materials whose excellence has been demonstrated over time. To be nominated, a work must have been in print 15 years and still be selling. The awards bear the name of William Holmes McGuffey, whose influential primers, which first appeared in 1836, helped bring the United States out of frontier illiteracy. McGuffey's Eclectic Readers, usually called simply McGuffey's Readers, were in print until 1921.
