1. A completed application form, with signed affirmation statement.
2. Invoices that demonstrate the nature of all costs incurred for which funds are requested, the entity that performed the service, the amount owed by the author(s),
3. Proof that the invoice was paid by the applicant.
4. Written indication from the publisher of acceptance for publication. It must show the name of the work, the name of the author(s) (at least one of whom must be the applicant), and the expected date of publication. Any payment that is due to the publisher from the author must be clearly delineated in the agreement or letter. Royalty arrangements, if any, must also be clearly delineated.
5. A description of the publisher's peer review process, if the author is not able to supply it in this questionnaire.
