

STEP 1. Write 15–30 minutes daily

STEP 2. Record and share daily


STEP 3. Write informally from the first day of your research project.

STEP 4. Outline based on an exemplar.

Writing daily by the numbers

- ❖ **2.7X as many pages and ms.**
- ❖ **From 2 ms./year to almost six**
- ❖ **And all this by writing
30 minutes/day, 4 days/week**

- ❖ **And the papers were better!**



year




